Review of regulations – the regulations were reviewed and correction to repeated wording in 1.1.1 was approved.

7. Future Works

Fencing around Oxted War Memorial – to contact Oxted Men in Sheds for quote Disabled parking slope – planning permission is not required.

Entrance gate – permission is not required from SCC.
