Why do we need your drawings?

- It will be displayed later.

The details -

Top tip - take a photograph of building for reference, then do your drawing indoors.

- We need drawings with clear outlines.
- You can colour them if you like.
- Any style you like.
- The drawings should be A5 size (21cm x 15cm).
- Write the name of the building & your name on the back of your drawing.
- Keep a photograph of your drawing if you like. We will not be able to return the original to you.
