## **Accessibility Statement**

This website is run by Oxted Parish Council. We want as many people as possible to be able to use this website. For example, that means you should be able to:

- zoom in up to 300% without the text spilling off the screen
- navigate most of the website using just a keyboard
- navigate most of the website using speech recognition software
- listen to most of the website using a screen reader (including the most recent versions of JAWS, NVDA and VoiceOver)

### **How accessible is this website?**

- We know some parts of this website aren't fully accessible:
- You can't modify the line height or spacing of text
- Some PDF documents aren't fully accessible to screen reader software
- You can't skip to the main content when using a screen reader
- There's a limit to how far you can magnify the map on our 'contact us' page
- We have plans in place to improve and make our website fully compliant
