MINUTES

The Chairman expressed thanks to all who attended the working party and assisted in clearing the burial ground.

1. Apologies for absence:

There were none received.

Declarations of Disclosable Pecuniary Interest: To receive any disclosure by members of personal interests in matters on the agenda, the nature of any interests, and whether the member regards the interest to be pecuniary under the terms of the Code of Conduct. There were none declared.

Public session: There were no members of the public present.

4. <u>Matters arising from the Councillors inspection of the burial ground prior to the meeting.</u>

- rose garden needs weeding.
- hedge by the stream requires cutting back.
- stream requires clearing.
- moss treatment on hard surfaces
- thistles plants on plots and by plots to be removed.
- there is a branch hanging (does not appear to be attached) from a tree on the right hand side of the footpath just up from the garden of remembrance.
- concern was expressed at the amount of loose grass cuttings around the site.

5. Burial Ground

 Rose gardens – It was agreed this area requires weeding and will be attended to by the maintenance team. The Clerk has communicated with the contractor who

- planted the roses and is awaiting a date when the edging of the areas will be attended to. Cllr Wallace and the Clerk will research which plants could be interspersed with the rose bushes to prevent the deer eating the flowers.
- Planting of additional trees It was agreed to request Country Garden Services to plant the remaining trees from Clerk's garden around the perimeter of the burial ground.
- Fees for plaques on benches It was agreed a fee of £75 will be charged for the erection of plaques on the benches in the burial ground. The wording must be agreed with the Clerk in advance and the plaques must be a uniform size.
- Maintenance to bin store area It was agreed to review the situation with the condition of the bin store area at the January 2024 Burial Ground Committee meeting.
- Decision regarding redesign of the roundabout It was agreed the roundabout area will be cleared, retarmac the ground and lay block paving under the circular bench. The Clerk will obtain quotes. Cllr Wallace will seek support from a local resident. Funding will be sought via a request in Hurst Green News and RH8 publications.

The Clerk has been unable to source any minutes for the Burial Ground Board.

8. Future Works

It was agreed to review the position regarding the locking and unlocking of the burial ground gates over the next couple of months. The issues that had instigated the locking of the gates appears to have been resolved.
